Red wine from the region of Beiras (Beira Interior), from our 85ha property in Figueira de Castelo Rodrigo, next to the convent of N^a Sr^a de Aguiar. There we planted several white and red varieties, of which we highlight Tinta Roriz and Touriga Nacional. Traditionally, this property produces very interesting wines with enormous personality - the so-called wines of altitude, for which our bet is frankly won when producing, in this so specific terroir, fresh red wines with great gastronomic capacity.
